How are groups going?

Groups are going well, making it work for them. As in many groups, some don't read the material, but wait for the leader to provide an over view of the text and chapter. I encourage leaders to do everything they can to encourage the group to read before they come. When sending out date reminders, possibly include the reminder to read the corresponding biblical text and add a theme encompassing question. New folks are being invited in when there is room. Leaders are getting better at recruiting their own new members through conversations in the congregation and as they meet new people.

Next Study

We plan on beginning a new study in September.

We all agree that whatever is chosen, we would like at least one meeting with the pastors for introduction and direction.

The study is most impactful when it is connected to Adult Education or ExALT themes.
