# TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Jason Cornell gave an overview of the budget process at Mountain View Lutheran Church (MVLC), including information on former accountants and how we came to hire our current bookkeeper. He went on to explain that all monies belonging to the church are safely in the bank. The process of handling deposits is well defined and designed to prevent the mishandling of church monies. Jason encouraged the council to question any large variances in transactions documented in the report.

Jason's goal is to retire the restricted funds that are sitting unused because no plan for using them exists. Two primary examples of restricted funds with no planned use include Worship and Music and Memorials.

### PASTOR/DEACON'S REPORTS

## **Pastor Eric**

Council members reviewed the report submitted by Pastor Eric while he updated Council on a variety of items.

Pastor Eric reminded council members who have not submitted a short biography and photo for the Council web page to do so soon.

Pastor Eric said that the contract with Paul Oman has been signed and the deposit paid. The remainder of the agreed upon fee remains to be paid. He described the format for the worship service and answered questions.

Keith Marshall has been elected Bishop for the Southwestern Washington Synod. Our new bishop will assume his role in August.

The estate of Linda Peterson includes a \$25K gift to MVLC. At this point in time consideration is being given to how this gift is to be used, but at the time of the council meeting, it was half to the Mission Endowment Fund (MEF) and half to youth programs - retreats or the youth annual trip.

Analysis of 2024 Christmas Eve services shows significantly increased attendance with an earlier schedule – 5 pm and 7 pm. Pastor Eric shared this information to prepare the council for future discussion about scheduling Christmas Eve Services.

Pastor Eric shared that he has a practice of meeting every month with the council president over coffee. He extended the invitation to members of the council. He is interested in hearing how/why we feel called to serve as council members.

#### **Deacon Traci**

Council members reviewed Deacon Traci's schedule of summer events while she provided a verbal update

Deacon Traci met with parents and mentors to discuss the policy statement, Mountain View Lutheran Church: Boundary Expectations for Adults – May 2025. Good feedback has been provided and resulting changes will be made and submitted for review and approval by the council.

## **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Vice President Megan Hutton addressed the reduced size of the council and that the quorum is now five members. If we cannot attain a quorum, consideration must be given to rescheduling the meeting since any action requiring a motion cannot be made.

# **Property Committee**

The council reviewed the Property Committee Report while Fred mentioned that the painting of the chapel project will start the week of June 23, weather permitting. The plan is to wait to paint the south side of the building until after the windows have been replaced and any necessary repairs have been completed.

# **Property Committee Report**

MVLC Property committee minutes June 2nd, 2025

### **Special presentation:**

Amy Boers presented "God's Work, Our Hands" which the ELCA has slated for Sept 7th, the same day as
our gathering back together for worship. The idea is to incorporate various community based projects
into that service. Amy requested the property committee would try and find various community projects
for our congregation to work on for that day.

# **Projects (active):**

- Martinson Painting will begin the Chapel project the week of June 23, weather permitting.
- The plan is to return and complete the south side of the chapel once the window repairs are done, (this is scheduled in July after VBS.)
- Honey doers will be repairing the facia on the west side of sanctuary

# Repair:

- Discussions that the water heater in the chapel is approx 20 years old, recommending replacement possibly with on-demand water heater.
- Henry is getting bids for parking lot light upgrades to LED fixtures
- Reviewed bids for metal roof replacement for MVCC. We passed bids onto Beth Ann Johnson for possible grant opportunities. Typically a 12-18 month timeline for the grant approval process

#### **Preventative:**

Carolyn Dahle has gotten bids from arborists to trim large oak tree along 122 Ave E.

#### **Pastor Eric**

Pastor Eric's Report to the June Council

- The contract for Paul Oman and Drawn to the Word is signed and delivered. A team of people is helping me prepare for Paul's visit on Aug 10, including building the frame and easel. The theme for Aug 10 will be the Sermon on the Mountain. The design of the worship will account for the 50 minutes that Paul takes to create his artwork. We will read through the sections of the Sermon on the Mountain in Matthew and break it up with instrumental music and reflective silence. Paul will also talk us through his creative process. During Communion, everyone will be able to take an up-close look at the artwork nearing its completion. The final wall space for the artwork will be in the hallway between the office entry and nursery.
