Call to order

President Carol Powers called the meeting to order.

Devotions

Emily Thompson led devotions based upon topics encountered in *Braving the Wilderness* by Brené Brown—belonging versus being alone and being vulnerable—and Psalm 100. The council prayed together.

Minutes

It was M/S/P to approve the minutes of the Tuesday 24 September 2019 meeting of the MVLC Church Council.

Financial update

September giving was within \$25 of expected levels, but year-to-date giving is still about \$32,000 below expected levels. However, we were still about \$11,900 higher than the same time last year (about 1.68% increase). Giving for the first Sunday in October was \$6,300 higher than the average weekly expected amount of \$21,106, but we are still \$25,636 below expected year-to-date giving levels.

2020 Spending Guideline

The MVLC Finance Committee—Michael Brauhn, Dave Cheney (email review), Church Administrator Phil Edlund, Neil Jerstad, and President

Carol Powers—met to discuss the "full request draft" of the proposed 2020 Spending Guideline, after receiving input from staff and ministry groups.

Three possible scenarios for the *total* 2020 Spending Guideline were produced and recommended for the MVLC Church Council to review and discuss—(a) with 0% salary increases for staff, \$1,119,137, 3.8% increase over 2019; (b) with 2.5% salary increase for staff, \$1,131,137, 4.9% increase over 2019; and (c) with 2% salary increases for staff, \$1,129,612, 4.7% increase over 2019.

Seminary fund/debt reduction

Pastor John proposed setting aside two \$6,000 scholarships for seniors/interns attending Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary from the Centennial Seminary Scholarship Fund. He would visit PLTS and interview four candidates identified by PLTS Director of Seminary Relations Brian Stein-Webber.

It was M/S/P to disperse two \$6,000 scholarships (\$12,000 total) from the Centennial Seminary Scholarship Fund to PLTS candidates identified by PLTS and interviewed by Pastor John Vaswig.

New council member orientation document Members of the MVLC Church Council reviewed the recently revised New Member Orientation sheets.
