

<sup>31</sup>rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race."





#### NICENE CREED

Together, let us confess our faith.




#### DISTRIBUTION

If gluten-free wafers are required for health reasons, then please ask the pastor serving communion for a wafer.






