

Part-Time Choir Director

About the Role

Mountain View Lutheran Church seeks a part-time Choir Director to lead, coordinate, and nurture our adult choir as part of our broader music ministry. This role focuses on choir development, rehearsals, music selection and performance planning.

Key Responsibilities

- Plan, promote, and lead weekly Adult Choir rehearsals (Sept–June)
- Select and acquire choral music suited to choir skill levels and worship themes
- Coordinate and direct choir performances for Sunday worship and special services
- Direct the Handbell Choir for seasonal or occasional performances
- Recruit and schedule worship vocal leaders, maintaining a balanced rotation
- Collaborate with Church Pianist, Pastoral Staff, Worship Planning Team, and Communications Director on music selections and worship integration.
- Coordinate and involve Pacific Lutheran University Student cohort in choir activities

Qualifications

- Experience directing church choirs
- Knowledge of liturgical worship
- Strong interpersonal skills and a collaborative, team-oriented mindset
- College-level music education and/or comparable experience preferred
- Ability to plan music well in advance of performances to meet publication deadlines

Hours & Compensation

- Part-time, hourly. Typically 10 hours a week, may expand to more hours based on seasonal activities.
