

## LETTER from the PRESIDENT

## Good morning,

Today (Monday, June 22, 2020) I bring good news about our search for an interim pastor. After several days of prayer and reflection, the interview team has decided to move forward with an interim team approach.

What this means is two pastors will fill the one position. Our interim pastor team will include Pastor Mike Greenwalt and Pastor Kim Latterell. Pastor Mike Greenwalt most recently served as the Interim pastor at Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd in Olympia and formerly has served as a Supervisory chaplain in both the Coast Guard and the Navy. Pastor Kim Latterell, who has worked with our congregation before, served as the Bishop's associate for six years and prior to that served at Creator Lutheran in Sumner.

So how is this going to work? Each of the pastors will have certain areas of emphasis. Pastor Mike will primarily lead the congregation for Word and Sacrament. He will support the council and staff through the transition activities.

Pastor Kim Latterell will serve in the area of pastoral care, crisis care, and deacon ministry. Both pastors will preach and preside throughout the month, and when Pastor Bri returns, she will be included in the rotation. Pastor Glenn will continue to preach occasionally.

Pastor Bri is planning to return in the latter part of August. Her call remains the same for family and youth ministry. Pastor Bri has been involved in this conversation and is excited to work with Pastor Mike and Pastor Kim.

In the coming weeks, we'll know more about schedules and which pastor will be involved with other areas such as the ministry groups, but we wanted to let you know about their arrival as soon as possible. They are planning to start on July 1. Keep watching the MVLC E-news for more updates


# MEET THE PASTORS


