## Mission Endowment Fund Grant Guidelines and Application MEF Fiscal Year 2025/26

The Mountain View Lutheran Church Mission Endowment Fund was established to provide financial support for the mission and ministry of Mountain View Lutheran Church. The purpose of this permanent fund is to, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, assist the community of Christ as it seeks to live out the love of God in Jesus Christ.

Each year the MEF Committee may distribute up to 10% of the June 30<sup>th</sup> balance of this year (June 30, 2025). Our focus areas are:

- 1. Missions: Local, Regional, and World Projects.
- 2. Education: College and seminary scholarships and special programs within Mountain View Lutheran Church.
- 3. Youth: Support for ministry and programs for youth of all ages.
- 4. Worship and Music: Support for the worship and music life of the church.
- 5. Capital Projects: major renovations and the building of new facilities.

Fund grant applications for 2025/26 are available at the church office, which must be completed and returned to the church office by **October 31, 2025**. Applicants will be interviewed by a two-member team from the MEF Committee. Grants will be presented in January, 2026

This application is available in a word format, so it can expand to enable you to have space you need to explain your project; however <u>please</u> keep in mind the committee will review multiple projects, so please be concise. **Hint**: Have a friend not connected to the project read your application before submission and ask them to describe the project to you afterwards. If they cannot accurately describe it, then go back in and add additional information.
